TITLE 730: MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY
CHAPTER 6.00: LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS AND TOURISM GRANT PROGRAM

6.06: Grant Proposal

(1) Authorization and Signature. If the eligible applicant is a city or town listed in [730 CMR 6.09](#) or [730 CMR 6.10](#), a grant proposal must be duly approved by the governing body and signed by the authorized signatory of the eligible applicant. If the eligible applicant is an entity described in [730 CMR 6.04\(2\)\(b\)](#), the grant proposal must be signed by the authorized signatory of the eligible applicant.

(2) Form and Content. The Authority specifies in its invitation for proposals the required form and content of a grant proposal.

(3) When and How Submitted. The Authority must receive a grant proposal no later than the date and time specified in the advertisement for the invitation for proposals referred to in [730 CMR 6.05](#). A grant proposal that the Authority receives subsequent to this date is not eligible for the Authority's consideration. An eligible applicant must address its grant proposal, consisting of one original and two complete and legible copies, to the Chairman of the Authority, and enclose it in an envelope or other container that prominently displays the words "Attention: Tourism Grant Program Proposal Under [730 CMR 6.00](#)."

(4) Clarifications and Amendments. The Authority may request, either at its own initiative or in response to a written communication from an eligible applicant, that an eligible applicant clarify its grant proposal by providing additional documents or written information or amend its grant proposal by changing programmatic or budgetary elements. The eligible applicant addresses any such clarification or amendment, consisting of an original and one complete and legible copy, to the Chairman of the Authority, and encloses it in an envelope or other container that prominently displays the words "Attention: Tourism Grant Program Proposal Under [730 CMR 6.00](#)."(1) Authorization and Signature. A Grant Proposal must be duly approved by the governing body and signed by the authorized signatory of a Qualified Applicant. In addition, if the Qualified Applicant is not a city or town listed in [730 CMR 6.09](#), or a regional entity described in 7:30 CMR 604(2)(b), the Grant Proposal must contain a certification signed by the authorized signatory of such a city or town in such form as the Authority may require from time to time.

(2) Form and Content. The Authority specifies in its Request for Proposals the required form and content of a Grant Proposal.

(3) When and How Submitted. The Authority must receive a Grant Proposal on or before April 30, 1996, for Grant Proposals submitted in 1996, and, for subsequent years, April 15 or the next business day following April 15 if April 15 falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Commonwealth holiday. A Grant Proposal that the Authority receives subsequent to this date is not eligible for the Authority's consideration unless the Chairman determines that compelling and extraordinary circumstances justify a waiver of the deadline. A Qualified Applicant must address its Grant Proposal, consisting of an original and one complete and legible copy, to the Chairman of the Authority and enclose it in an envelope or other container that prominently displays the words "Attention: Grant Proposal Under [730 CMR 6.00](#)." A Qualified Applicant normally submits its Grant Proposal to the Authority through an

elected member of the Great and General Court of the Commonwealth who represents the city or town for the benefit of which the Grant Proposal is submitted, although the Authority may waive this requirement at the request of the city or town.

(4) Clarifications and Amendments. The Authority may request, either at its own initiative or in response to a written communication from a Qualified Applicant, that a Qualified Applicant clarify its Grant Proposal by providing additional documents or written information or amend its Grant Proposal by changing programmatic or budgetary elements. The Qualified Applicant addresses any such clarification or amendment, consisting of an original and one complete and legible copy, to the Chairman of the Authority and encloses it in an envelope or other container that prominently displays the words "Attention: Grant Proposal Under [730 CMR 6.00](#)." The Qualified Applicant submits any such clarification or amendment directly to the Authority, with a copy to the member of the Great and General Court who submitted the Grant Proposal in accordance with 7.30 CMR 6.06(3).
